The Chesapeake and Potomac Section Institute of Transportation Engineers (CAPSITE) Scholarship is presented annually to encourage students to consider Transportation Engineering or Planning in their studies and pursue a career in the field of transportation. This scholarship is intended to appreciate and provide financial support to students who have demonstrated extraordinary interest in the transportation field. The scholarship will be provided up to **three (3) undergraduate or graduate students** in the amount of **\$1,000** each.

Scholarship recipients will be contacted and will be encouraged to attend the scholarship award presentation at the CAPSITE annual meeting.

Eligibility Requirements

Student applicants must fulfill the following requirements to receive the award:

- Must be currently enrolled in a college or university in Northern Virginia¹, Maryland or District of Columbia in Civil Engineering or related degree program.
- Undergraduate and graduate students are encouraged to apply.

Application Instructions

To apply for the CAPSITE Student Scholarship, the candidate must complete and submit the scholarship application (one PDF document) to the Scholarship Committee Chair via email. If necessary, attach additional sheets, but information not specifically requested in the application will be discarded. Do not include this document as a cover page/front matter.

- Application package must be sent electronically and completed as follows:
 - From Applicant
 - **CAPSITE Scholarship Application Form**
 - Delivered as PDF document and named as follows:
 - "CAPSITE Scholarship Application 2025_LastName_FirstName.pdf"
 - Copy of personal resume or CV (max one page PDF)
 - From Reference
 - **CAPSITE Reference Form**
 - This form must be sent directly from the advisor and/or professor to the Scholarship Committee Chair.
 - Applicants may submit up to two (2) reference forms, at least 1 must be from an advisor or university professor.

¹ Northern Virginia within CAPSITE consists of Arlington County, Fairfax County, Loudoun County, Prince William County, independent cities within their confines, and the City of Alexandria.



Evaluation

Applications will be evaluated by the CAPSITE Scholarship Committee on the categories listed below. The categories will be weighted according to the strengths of the applicant pool. The categories are listed but not limited to the following:

- Academic Achievement
- Community Involvement and Volunteering
- Leadership Positions
- Professional Experience
- Professional Organization Involvement
- Recommendation by professor, engineering or transportation professional
- Student Organization Involvement
